

## Swanson Lake Ranch, LLC RANCH VEHICLE SAFETY RULES & GUIDELINES

## Note: These guidelines apply to all Ranch Vehicles, including but not limited Tractors, UTVs (Polaris Rangers), etc, and are for YOUR SAFETY. PLEASE READ!

- 1. Sign a **liability waiver** before riding or driving ranch vehicles at Swanson Lake Ranch.
- A valid driver's license is required to drive a ranch vehicle and persons age 16-20 are not permitted to drive a ranch vehicle unless accompanied by an adult (person at least 21 years of age).
- 3. Unsafe operation of a ranch vehicle can lead to significant injury or death.
- 4. Be familiar with the operation of your vehicle. Ask if you do not understand its use.
- 5. Drive within your limits and always wear a helmet and seatbelts.
- 6. The Maximum Speed Limit on Swanson Lake Ranch properties is 15 MPH.
- 7. Keep a safe distance between you and the ranch vehicle in front of you.
- 8. Slow down for turns to avoid rolling the vehicle.
- 9. Avoid rocks, logs or other obstacles which could affect your steering.
- 10. Keep away from the edge of the trail getting a tire off the edge will send you off course.
- 11. Try to **keep the ranch vehicles as level as possible** to avoid rolling. When on a slope, always lean uphill to stabilize the vehicle.
- 12. No riders under 6 years of age.
- 13. Never ride under the influence of alcohol or other drugs including prescription drugs.
- 14. Ride in a group for greatest safety. Inform others of your expected route if you ride alone.
- 15. No standing in the cargo area of UTVs and other ranch vehicles. All passengers must be seated while the vehicle is moving.
- 16. Absolutely no loaded firearms while traveling in a ranch vehicle.
- 17. Unsafe operation of Winches and other equipment related to ranch vehicles can lead to significant injury or death. Be familiar with the operation of this equipment before using.
- **18. Stay the Trail!** UTVs and off-road vehicles are to be used on designated trails only. Please refer to a map of Swanson Lake Ranch.
- 19. UTVs and off-road vehicles are Not to be driven on County Roads.
- **20. Limit Use**. Please limit use of all UTVs and off-road vehicles to game retrieval and work duty.
